nothing from the Tooth Fairy



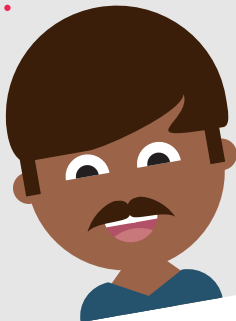
PARENTS REPORT ON TOOTH FAIRY TRENDS

Dads \$3.63

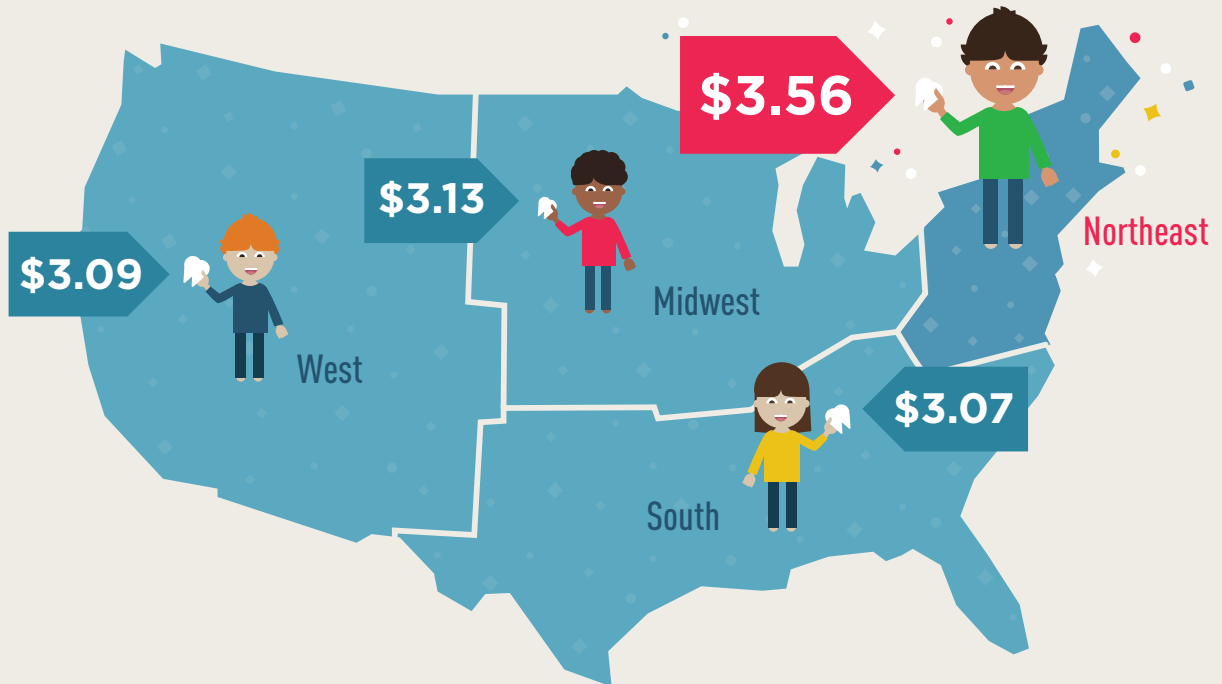


For the past 5 years, Dads consistently report that the Tooth Fairy is more generous
